A modern hybrid successor to the Greek kithar, the English lute, the Italian mandolin and the Baroque guitar, this instrument utilizes both ancient and contemporary elements. Its mellow-sounding nylon strings and warm tone woods make it the perfect instrument for entertaining intimate crowds. In fact, well-known composer Heitor Villa-Lobos spent much of his life traveling his native Brazil, playing his guitar in cafés while collecting folk tunes to arrange for both guitar and symphony orchestra.
